Short Term Goals

- Mosquito nets: Malaria is very prevalent problem in this area. We need to make sure every child's bed has a proper mosquito net. These are inexpensive and can save lives!
- 2. Stable funds for food: Our children eat a carbohydrate-heavy diet. They lack vegetables, fruit and meat. Your donation ensure that we have a reliable and nutritious supply of food.
- 3. Fence: Although Amani has round-the-clock security, we have temporary wire fence that we want to replace with a gated brick wall. Please help us make sure our kids are safe day and night



Long Term Goals

1. Agricultural Project

We currently relay on donations for supply of food, but want to move to a self-sustaining model. We plan to buy a local plot of land for year-long cultivation. This will provide Amani with a predictable source of food, as well as supplement income for our staff. By contributing to this crucial project, you will help ensure that Amani can support itself for years to come.



2. School Project

In 2014, donors helped Amani create a brand - new two -room school. However, in order to complete our onsite school, we need to add a second two-story building to house the remaining 5 classes. Once we finish this huge goal, not only can we instruct our own children on site, but also offer a fantastic education to the local community.
